**IPBib – Librarianship Students Mobility**

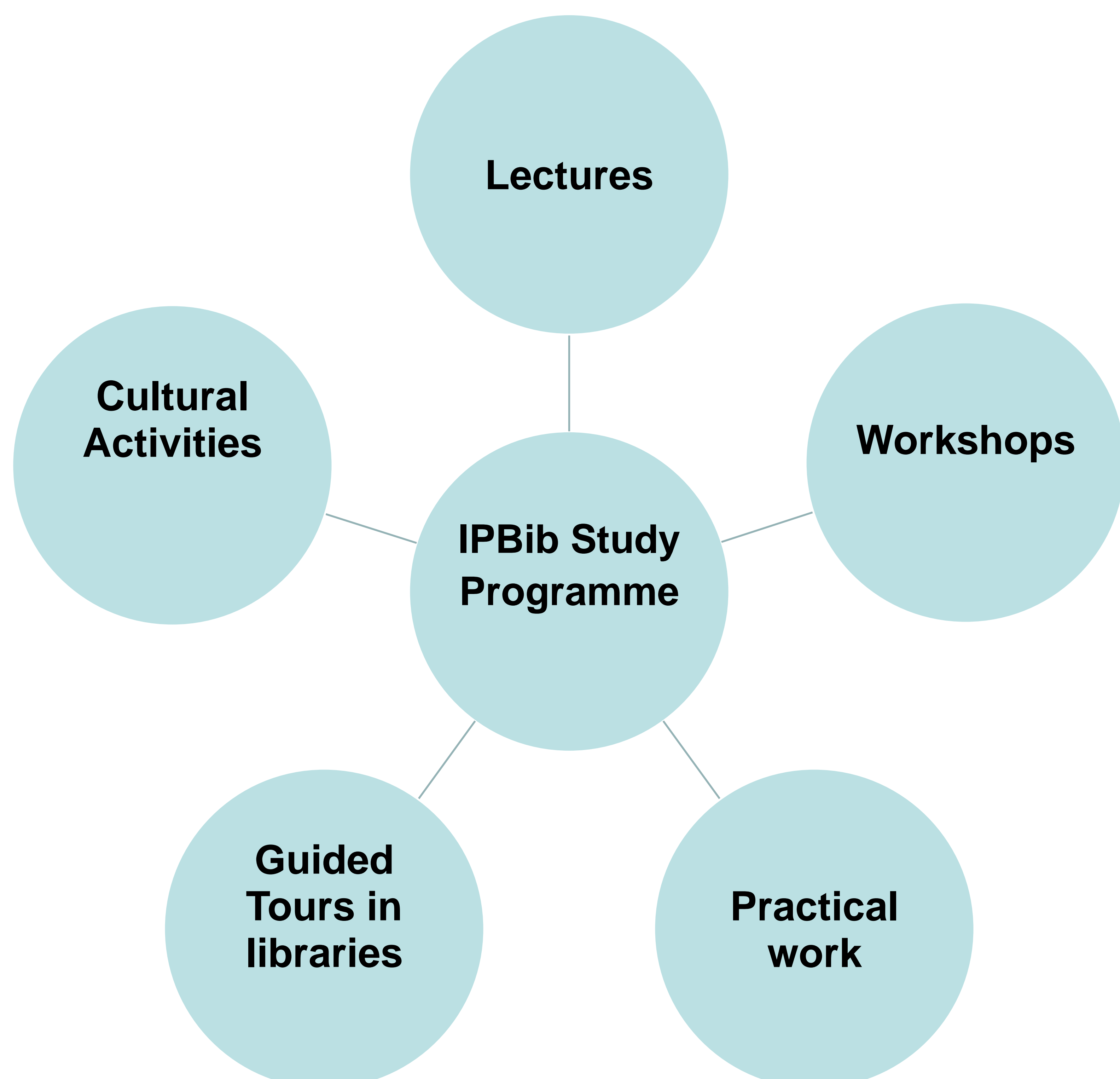
